



Student Expectations

- **Payment program forms and class contracts must be signed and returned to your instructor by the third day of class.**
- **Write your full legal name on all contracts, student record sheets, and tests.**
- **All classes must be passed, completed or made up before you can take the final written exam (class #15)**
- **You may make up, (3) three classes maximum. Driving 101 follows the Washington State Law that says, if you miss (4) four scheduled classes, or exceed 26 weeks in length you must start the program over.**
- **If you have to retake the course there will be no charge for the classroom portion. (fee waived one time) However you will be required to buy back your drives to complete the program. (\$35.00 per drive)**

Scheduling Drives

- To pass this course the law requires you do (6) six hour behind the wheel, (1) one hour observation, and (30) thirty hours of classroom time.
- The state requires that you have 50 (fifty) hours of practice to attain your license. We instruct for (7) seven hours, you are responsible to practice for the other 43 hours.
- Students schedule their own drives. If your parents would rather schedule drive times, call the office at 360-892-6988. Mon- Fri, between the hours of 12pm - 5pm.
- At the end of each drive your instructor will recommend you practice 2-4 hours before your next drive. Driving 101 requires that you wait one week between drives, you may find it beneficial to schedule all (6) six of your drives in advance.
- Due to availability drives can be booked out one or two weeks. Schedule in advance to avoid conflicts.

- Drive (1) one, schedule after class 1
- Drive (2) two, schedule after class 3
- Drive (3) three, schedule after class 5
- Drive (4) four, schedule after class 7
- Drive (5) five, schedule after class 9
- Drive (6) six, schedule after class 11
- Observation, schedule anytime, observe another student's drive for (1) one hour
- Drive (7) seven: This drive is a bonus review drive. It is not required by the state to complete the class. Schedule (2) two weeks before you plan on taking your drive test at the DOL.

Note: *Drvn101 can't guarantee that there will be an observer in the car at all times. If this is a concern to you, we recommend you schedule drives at a time that is convenient for a parent to stay and ride along. Any passengers will be required to remain quite in the back seat during the drive.*

Drive Cancellations:

In order to avoid fees, just don't miss your drives. We let you schedule your drive times and we call to remind you the day before so there should never be an issue about missing drives. If for any reason you must cancel a scheduled drive, call the office by 5:00 pm the business day before your scheduled drive, if your drive is on Monday you need to notify the office by 5:00pm Friday. If we do not answer leave a message, the voice mail will tell us the time and date of your call.

If Driving 101 must cancel your drive due to weather (ice, snow, ECT) we will put information on our voicemail. If you are concerned that your drive will be cancelled, call the office. As soon as Driving 101 cancels drives the office will try to contact you immediately.

Fees Policy

- There will be a \$35.00 charge to your account if you skip a scheduled drive, forget your permit, bring an expired permit, schedule a drive during a scheduled class, or if you are more than 20 minutes late.
- If you color or scratch the classroom tables you will be charged to repair or replace the table.
